# ZACH 60 Area

- All students assigned an office in this area shall attend an annual security briefing and demonstrate they are familiar with their individual responsibilities relative to maintaining security in this area
  - A list shall be maintained by the department of those personnel assigned desk/offices in the 60 area
- No unescorted access will be allowed in this area unless the person is a designated Texas A&M employee or a student that has a security form on file with the department
  - If any other person is given access into the area, they MUST be escorted to the person they are in the area to visit by a person having unescorted access authority
- If anyone is permitted access to this area during the year, they shall be given the security briefing when keys for the 60 area are issued

# ZACH 60C

- Room 60C shall always have only students who are U.S. citizens assigned a desk in the room
  - and the outer door to this room shall remain closed and locked at all time unless one of these assigned students or a person who has unescorted access authority is present in the room

# AGN Reactor Room

- All personnel shall be escorted into the reactor room by licensed facility personnel
  - no unescorted access to the reactor room is permitted
  - all backpacks, briefcases, purses, and other items shall be left in 60C prior to entering the reactor room area
- During higher levels of alert (orange or above) access to the reactor room shall be limited to only necessary activities that must be performed in the facility

# ZACH 133 Area

## (Radiation Detection Teaching Labs)

- Limited access shall be maintained to the laboratory area
  - no students are allowed unescorted access to this area unless they have an office/laboratory in this area or are student workers for the department
- During laboratories and classes held in the 133 area, the students must be escorted at all times by the professor/TA or student workers
- The double doors to the 133 area shall always be locked and closed, unless in use, and must always be under observation if held open for any reason

# ZACH 135

## (Shao Lab)

- The 135 room has a list of personnel approved for unescorted access
  - all others must be escorted
- The door to this room will always be locked and shut unless work is being performed in the area, and the door is open under observation
- During higher security conditions (orange or above) the door **WILL** remain closed and locked even if work is ongoing inside the 135 room

# Teague Building

- The Teague Building has controlled access at night and on weekends
  - Access to the building at these times requires use of a badge reader
  - Students with offices in Teague will be added to the authorized access list
  - Students with authorized access may escort anyone you trust into the building with you

# New Facility Personnel

- A background check must be performed by the University on all newly-hired personnel
  - Their hiring shall be designated by the department to be Security Sensitive, and this will automatically cause Human Resources at the University to conduct a background investigation
- If someone that is already an employee of the university wishes to obtain a license on the AGN-201, then the need for a background check shall be determined on a case by case basis
