

Setting up a Personal Website

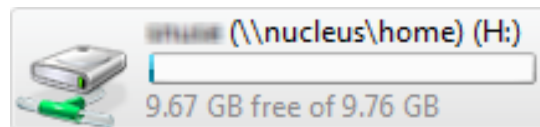
With any NE departmental computer account each user can set up their own personal website as long as it adheres to the network policies outlined on the Nuclear Engineering website. These policies can be found at:

After reviewing these policies the user is ready to begin developing their own website.

Essentially each website will be created with the standard URL of <http://nuclear.tamu.edu/~username> where 'username' is the user's username.

To set up your own website start by creating a folder called 'www' on your own 'H' drive



Creating a new folder consists of clicking Organize > New Folder.

Once this folder has been created the user can then put their web files inside of it. Developing each personal website is the responsibility of the user and the NE faculty will not be able to support any coding requests. Many help files exist online available through most search engines (Google, MSN, Yahoo, etc...).
